

Report on the 26th DOWAS National Conference

The FY2022 26th DOWAS National Conference was held Wednesday October 26.

As with last year, this year's conference was held completely online to prevent the spread of COVID-19, and was the third year in a row that we were unable to gather.

Regarding the number of research presenters, there were 15 general research presentations, one poster presentation titled "The Current Status of DOW products 2022" from the Utilization Promotion Committee, and a special presentation from the Education Promotion Committee. A total of 17 announcements were made for "Introduction to Committee Activities," in addition, regarding submissions from overseas, there was a presentation from South Korea.

There were applications to participate from 61 members, 8 non-members for a total of 69 people. On the day there were 55 members, 4 non-members and 3 overseas participants (2 from South Korea, 1 from Taiwan).

For general research presentations, in addition to themes such as "energy-related, aquaculture-related, environment-related, resource conservation-related, microorganism-related, and food use-related," there was also one presentation on the maintenance of water intake facilities.

The allotted time for presentations was 15 minutes per topic, including time for questions and answers, and overall, the presentations went smoothly.
